

1) REGISTRATION – The TEAM ROSTER must be faxed into the Soccerplex at (514) 639-4701 or scanned and e-mailed paolos1@videotron.ca by no later than Thursday August 27th, 2009.

2) REGISTRATION – DAY 1 of FESTIVAL (SATURDAY) - A team representative must register the team for the Festival at least ONE HOUR before your team's first game of the festival. At registration, which will be held on the 2nd floor of the Soccerplex, the complete original TEAM ROSTER sheet, as well as the 4 duly filled out GAME SHEETS (one for each game) must be handed in for validation. For the registration, the team representatives must bring the players' passports. In the case of house league teams without passports, a photocopy of the players' Medicare cards will be accepted in lieu of the passports. The Medicare card numbers must appear on both the TEAM ROSTER and the GAME SHEETS in the field designated for the passport numbers.

30 minutes before each game, the FIELD MARSHALLS of the individual fields on which your teams will be playing on will verify the following: GAME SHEETS for the game in question, passports/Medicare cards and players. Once verified, one of the players' hands will be stamped. This will indicate that the players have been duly registered. Only players with stamped hands will be allowed to play in the games. Referees will be checking for the stamps prior to each game.

3) GAME REGULATIONS - All Games will be played according to Lac-St-Louis outdoor 7 aside regulations. For the indoor games, the only exception will be when/if the ball touches the overhead structure or lights, at which point Lac-St-Louis indoor league regulations shall apply. Game duration will be 50 minutes (two 25 minute halves) but will be called at :57 on the hour. We ask that you please vacate the field immediately after your game.

At the end of the game, the traditional hand shake between two teams will not be allowed. Instead, we ask that the two teams approach the center of the field together and clap their hands in appreciation of the opposing team. Parents are not to enter or cross the fields.

4) TRAVELING PERMITS – Those teams travelling from outside the Lac St. Louis region must present themselves with their travelling permits at registration.

5) DRESSING ROOMS – Dressing rooms are available at the Soccerplex for each team. The dressing rooms will be assigned to the teams at REGISTRATION. The dressing rooms will be available from :15 to :30 on the hour preceding your game time, and from :00 to :14 on the hour immediately after your games. A Team representative must be present at all times in the dressing room, and at no time will players be admitted into the dressing rooms without a team representative. Dressing rooms are provided for players to get changed into their equipment. Players are not to leave their equipment or clothes in the dressing rooms during or after their games, as other teams will be using these dressing rooms throughout the course of the festival. Locks will not be permitted on the dressing room doors and will be cut off.

6) FIELDS - All the games are played at the Soccerplexe Catalogna, located at 775, 1st Avenue in Lachine. There are 5 fields at the Soccerplexe which will be used, two outdoor fields and three indoor fields. Each field has been “named” for this tournament. The “Field Locations” file will give you a general overview of the field locations at the Soccerplexe.

For those teams coming from East of Lachine who would normally take the 1st avenue overpass, please prepare your travel itinerary knowing that this overpass crossing Highway 20 is closed.

7) TEAM TENTS – The end zones of the outdoor field are made available for those teams who have team tents/canopies and wish to set them up for the festival. It is the responsibility of the individual teams to set up and take down the tents on each day of the festival, as no festival volunteers will be made available to assist in this other than validating where the tents may be set up.

8) GIFTS – At registration, a bag containing gifts for the players will be given to team representatives. We ask that you distribute these to your players after your first game. Also, prior to the last game of your festival, we ask that a team representative come by the festival information/administration office, located inside the Soccerplexe, to pick up a bag containing medals for the players. We ask that you distribute these to your players after your last game. There will be other surprise in store for your kids, so please tell their parents not to forget their cameras.

9) FOOD AND BEVERAGE – Food and drinks will be available for purchase at the Soccerplexe restaurant and outdoor BBQ. No food from the outside will be permitted onto the premises.
